

## Now you've learnt about how to be safer at home, think about accidents that can happen when you're outside playing.

We want you to make a poster about accidents when you're out with your family or with your friends. Think about one of the following places and decide what you think the dangers might be that you could help your friends or other children to avoid?

- **At the swimming pool, near a canal or river or even a garden pond**

Clue: what happens if you fall in and can't swim?

- **At the seaside**

Clue: currents and tides can be dangerous if you swim out too far.

- **In the garden**

Clue: plants and berries from the garden can be dangerous to eat.

Your poster can be a painting, a drawing or a collage. You can choose to show one of the dangers above or you can think of some yourself – it's up to you!

There are four age groups for this competition:

**Age 3-4 / Age 5-7 / Age 8-11 / Age 12-14**

We will choose a winner from each age group. Each winner will receive a £20 voucher to spend on CDs, DVDs, books or colouring sets.
